Special Class for children with a diagnosis of ASD

Our school has been allocated a special class for children with a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). We have been working on this for a long time and were delighted to receive confirmation that our class can now be established.

The school will receive additional staffing and training in this area. This will add to our expertise in supporting and understanding our children with Autism. The class will be a great addition to our school and also to the community of Carndonagh.

Literacy & Numeracy Summer Camp

This year we will run a Literacy & Numeracy Summer Camp on two different weeks for two different groups of children. Week 1 (8th to 12th July) is for Infants and First Class. Week 2 (15th to 19th July) is for Second, Third & Fourth Class. This camp will focus on fun and games for the teaching of Literacy & Numeracy. The theme this year is <u>Building Confidence and Connections</u>. This promises to be a great camp. The course is free (although funding is significantly reduced from last year) and children will receive a free camp T-shirt.

In conjunction with the DEIS camp, we will also run a Primary School Scheme/Camp and the children involved will attend for two weeks. This camp replaces the home-based summer programme of recent years.

Please note all children will be taught together regardless of which camp they are attending.
